I write in connection with your request for information received by Norfolk Constabulary on the 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020 in which you sought access to the following information:

Under the freedom of Information, I would like to know how many times the police have been called to, have arrested, given cautions or given warning or other, to someone who is homeless or in a hostel at McDonalds at the Haymarket, Norwich, in the last 6 months. I would like to know what the crime was committed, if any.

**Response to your Request**

The response provided below is correct as of 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

Norfolk Constabulary has considered your request and our response is below.

Research has been undertaken of recorded incidents or arrests in the location of the McDonalds, Haymarket, Norwich. The results have then been reviewed to see if they related to someone who is homeless or in the hostel. The results will therefore not include anyone from the hostel who has committed offences, or been involved in any incidents, away from the Haymarket location.
