**Freedom of Information Request Reference N°: FOI 002384/20**

I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk and Suffolk Constabularies on the 14<sup>th</sup> July 2020 in which you sought access to the following information:

How many times between 1.1.2019 and 31.12.2019 (inclusive) and 1.1.2020 and 10.7.2020 has your force arrested either the son or daughter of a serving police officer who serves with your force? Who was then charged with a criminal offence or given a police caution

How many offences in each the categories below were charged or caution issued

- Arson and criminal damage
- Burglary
- Drug offences
- Historical fraud and Forgery
- Miscellaneous crimes against and society
- Possession of weapons
- Public Order offences
- Robbery
- Sexual offences
- Theft
- Vehicle offences
- Violence against the person

OR

How many police officers who are serving with your force have you been made aware, that either their son or daughter has been arrested by your force and is waiting to appear in court

NB Son or daughter is to be taken to mean biological parents, adoptive parents, foster parents or for any person they are acting in loco parentis.

**Response to your Request**

The response provided below is correct as of 21<sup>st</sup> July 2020.

Norfolk and Suffolk Constabularies have considered your request and our response is below.

The Joint Professional Standards Department has undertaken a review of their records for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 to 10<sup>th</sup> July 2020. The information relates to either serving Police Officers of members of the Special Constabulary.

## NORFOLK

Two officers have notified the Joint Professional Standards Department that their son/daughter had been arrested within the time period above. One resulted in a youth caution for theft and no further action was taken in respect of the other arrest.

## SUFFOLK

One officer notified the Joint Professional Standards Department that their son/daughter had been arrested, within the time period above, resulting in a charge for theft.
