The response provided below is correct as of 13<sup>th</sup> August 2018. Norfolk Constabulary has located the following information as relevant to your request.

The Professional Standards Department has undertaken a review of misconduct cases to identify those cases where a Police Officer has appeared at court, within the last five financial years. Each of the cases relate to police prosecutions for criminal matters.
