I write in connection with your request for information received by Norfolk Constabulary on the 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019 in which you sought access to the following information:

Please can you tell me how much Norfolk Constabulary has spent on policing Extinction Rebellion climate change protests over the past 12 months (1/1/19 – 28/8/19)

Please could I have the data broken down into the date and location of the protest as well as the cost of resources, including if officers had to be called in from days off or lent to other forces.

Norfolk Constabulary provided officers to the Metropolitan Police on mutual aid (lent) during the period 19/4/19 to 21/4/19. The Met were invoiced £26,313 for these officers. This was for **all** officer hours, including 'rostered' shifts and overtime, and any allowances/travel claimed
