Suspected arson attack Old Hall, Little Plumstead, NR13 5EW

Under the Freedom of Information Act, disclose as much information as possible in relation to the type and amount of incidents Norfolk Constabulary have been called to at The Old Hall since 01 January 2016 until the fire destroyed the building on Sunday 14 August 2016.

### Response to your Request

Norfolk Constabulary has located the following information as relevant to your request.

The Constabulary's Contact and Control Room has received 4 calls, during the period requested, in relation to The Old Hall, Little Plumstead. Please see further details below:-

| Date & Time      | Details of Call   | Outcome  |
|------------------|---|--|
| 27/02/2016 14:54 | Youths hanging around, believed to have gone inside. It is boarded up but they have gained entry.   | Police attendance, no youths on scene. Due to the premises being derelict, damage all over, difficult to see if there is any new damage.   |
| 05/03/2016 16:04 | The old hall building is all boarded up and there are 2 persons on the flat roof. Regular problem here.   | Officer attended and 3 persons spoken to. Not climbing on roofs when seen. Details taken.  |
| 28/04/2016 07:55 | Caller is working on the Old Hall development site. Overnight someone has sprayed graffiti on the outside of the building wall. They have got in through the back entrance to the site. They have pulled over some steel fencing which has been damaged in the process. They have also got into the building itself by pulling one of the boards away from the windows. | Officer attended. No persons have entered the building, The boarding up had been removed from a broken window. There is no way anyone could have got through the gap in the broken glass window. |
| 17/07/2016 17:54 | 4-5 vehicles and possibly 12 persons trying to break into the dis-used Plumstead Hospital. Persons have got spades and are putting them under the fence to prise them open. Caller states this has happened several times before. Possibly being used for vandalism or raves?   | Officers attended. Have been round the whole site. Nobody here and nothing heard. No signs of any break etc.   |
