Norfolk Constabulary has located the following information as relevant to your request.

The Constabulary has recorded 15 crimes in relation to the theft of a mobility scooter during 2015. The results are based on the property type stolen being entered as a mobility scooter. If a value has been recorded this has been provided. No reasons for stealing the items have been recorded on the crime reports.
