**Freedom of Information Request Reference N<sup>o</sup>: FOI 003657/17**

I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk Constabulary on the 20<sup>th</sup> February 2017 in which you sought access to the following information:

You recently provided me with information from an FOI request (004250/16) regarding road rage incidents. Thank you very much for the information. The data for the year 2016 was up to the 30<sup>th</sup> November and I would now like to resubmit my request so that the 2016 figure is for the whole 12 months of the year.

I don't need a fresh search for 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 but I would like the complete annual data for 2016.

Norfolk Constabulary holds information relevant to your request.

**Response to your Request**

Norfolk Constabulary has located the following information as relevant to your request.

The Joint Performance and Analysis Department has undertaken research of recorded crimes where the following phrases have been included within the text:-

- 'road rage'
- 'driving aggressively'
- 'driving in a panic'

This research has located the following crimes. Please note – the crimes have **not** been reviewed to ascertain the incident circumstances. For example, whilst undertaking the research, one crime referred to the victim not being aware of any 'road rage' incident that may have led to their vehicle being damaged.

The figures provided are for the full calendar year.
