I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk Constabulary on the 16th November 2016 in which you sought access to the following information:

Can you please provide me with details of the structure of your Neighbourhood Policing Teams, NOT Response Teams.

IE: Each team has 1 Insp, 2 Sgts, 3 Constables and 4 PCSOs or
1 Insp covers 2 teams, 2 Sgts, 3 Constables and 4 PCSOs.

Response to your Request

Norfolk Constabulary does not hold information relevant to your request.

Norfolk Constabulary's Safer Neighbourhood and Response Teams are integrated therefore there is no structure for just the Neighbourhood Policing Teams. The Constabulary has dedicated Beat Managers and PCSOs who lead on neighbourhood policing. There is a dedicated Beat Manager (Police Constable) for each of the 52 neighbourhoods and approximately 1 PCSO for each neighbourhood. These officers and staff are supervised by Response Sergeants.
