I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk Constabulary on the 5th December 2016 in which you sought access to the following information:

As you may be aware, Norfolk county council are currently out to consultation regarding proposed cuts to school crossing patrol services across the county.

In order to gauge the level of dangerous driving on the stretch of road from Mile End road/Newmarket road roundabout to Colman road/Earlham road roundabout, the A140 running past Colman Infant school, please could you advise on a monthly basis over the past 12 months (or if in action for less than 12 months the amount of operational time) the following:

The number of times per month the speed camera outside Colman Library and the speed camera on Mile End road have been triggered by vehicles breaking the speed limit.

The speeds vehicles captured by the speed cameras were travelling.

Norfolk Constabulary holds information relevant to your request.
