I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk Constabulary on the 29<sup>th</sup> December 2016 in which you sought access to the following information:

Please could you tell me how many crimes were recorded from the week beginning Sunday 11 December to week ending Saturday 24 December inclusive of burglaries relating to Christmas presents/gifts?

Please could you tell me what date and where each crime occurred - the town/city/village is fine - and value of the stolen items in each case? If possible could you detail the type of present – ie child's toy?
