I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk Constabulary on the 26<sup>th</sup> April 2017 in which you sought access to the following information:

Can I request any disclosable data held by Norfolk Constabulary on RTC's, or road traffic collisions on Beach Road, Cromer over the last 10 years.

Obviously, I am not requesting any data that may be withheld under the Data Protection Act that may identify individuals involved in any recorded collisions.

If possible, can the data include times and dates of the collisions?

Norfolk Constabulary holds information relevant to your request.

**Response to your Request**

Norfolk Constabulary has located the following information as relevant to your request.

The map at the end of this letter details injury collisions recorded by the Constabulary in relation to Beach Road. Cromer.

In addition to those detailed on the map, the following have been reported to the Constabulary's Contact and Control Room for Beach Road, Cromer:-

24<sup>th</sup> March 2007 – Lorry hit and damaged a road sign but did not stop.

21<sup>st</sup> September 2011 – 3 vehicle collision – damage only.

9<sup>th</sup> February 2016 – 2 vehicle collision resulting in a minor injury.
