I write in connection with your request for information received by Norfolk Constabulary on the 10th May 2017 in which you sought access to the following information:

Thank you for your response and explanation as to the Section 12 refusal. So the request can be processed, I am prepared to narrow its original scope.

Please can I instead request details on the number of occasions police in the force area have been called to incidents where use of the drug 'Spice' has been recorded for the time period March 2016 to March 2017. This is half the time period I was originally requesting.

Secondly, to eliminate results including 'hospice' etc, please feel free to search for the terms 'smoking Spice' or 'smoked Spice'.

The response provided below is correct as of 10th May 2017

Norfolk Constabulary has located the following information as relevant to your request.

Research has been undertaken of incident reports raised by the Constabulary's Contact and Control Room using a keyword search of 'Spice'. The results have been reviewed to remove any that do not refer to the drug 'spice'. The remaining reports have not been reviewed to see how 'spice' is relevant to the incident, as this has not been requested.
