People are driving so quickly down it I am often having to slam on breaks and its quite scare driving down this road now, my friend who used to keep her horse in a field on the road has moved as she was so scared to ride down the road anymore. At the moment the road has no speed limit. I would like to try to get this changed to 30 MPH and wondered if you knew of any other accidents on this street recently that I could quote to the traffic department to give me ammunition to try to get it changed?
